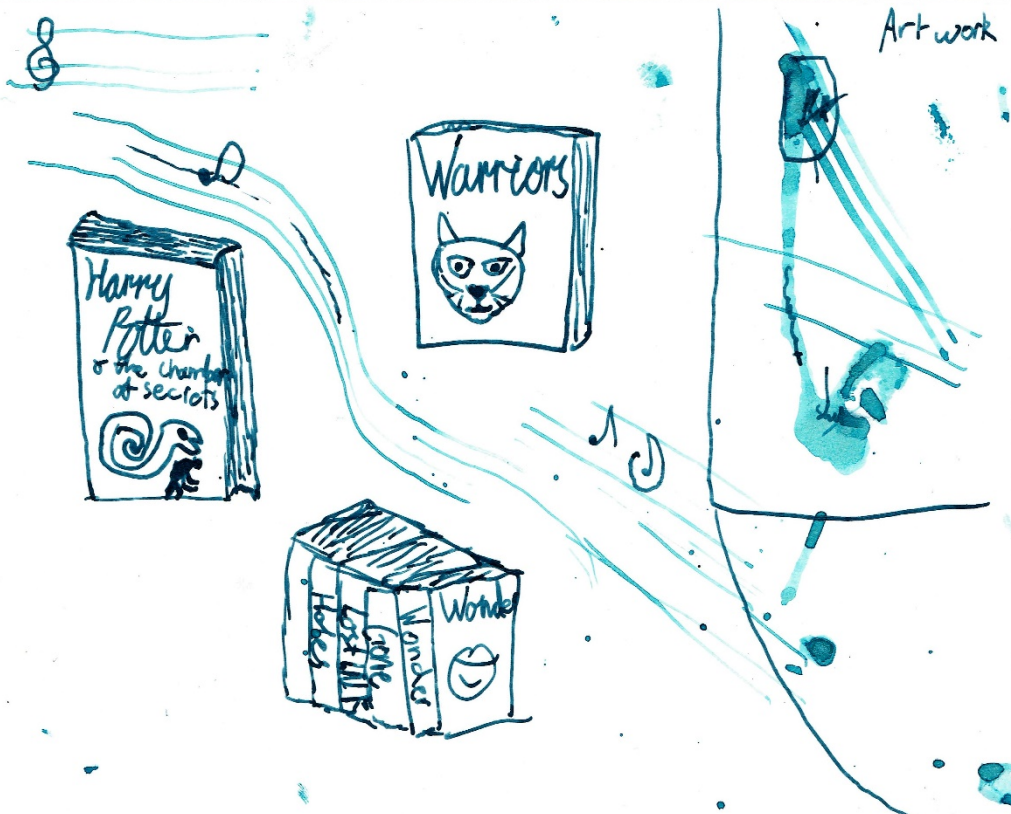
Dear Bruce,
